

The College of Opticians of Ontario proposes to make the following changes to its by-laws:

1. Changing the titles of Council roles and College Members

The College is proposing changes to the titles of Council roles and College Members to make their roles and responsibilities clearer to the public and more consistent with the nomenclature of boards. The College has proposed the following amendments:

1. Introducing a mandatory cooling off period for individuals who held positions within professional associations.

The College is considering a mandatory 3 year cooling off period for any person who has held a position at any professional association for opticians before becoming a council or committee member at the College. This proposal is meant to ensure a clear separation between the College, which has a mandate to protect the public, and the professional opticianry associations, who have a mandate to advocate for opticians.

The following chart sets out the wording of the proposed new by-laws and an explanation for each proposed by-law.

ARTICLE 6: ELECTED COUNCIL MEMBERS¹

6.3 Eligibility for Election

A Member is eligible for election to Council in an electoral district if, on the deadline for the receipt of nominations and up to and including the date of the election:

(h) the Member has resigned, before being nominated for election, any position such as director, owner, board member, officer or employee that the Member holds with a professional association relating to opticianry;

A Member Registrant is eligible for election to Council the Board in an electoral district if, on the deadline for the receipt of nominations and up to and including the date of the election:

(h) the Member Registrant has resigned, at least three years prior to before being nominated for election, any position such as director, owner, board member, officer or employee that the Member Registrant holds with a professional association relating to opticianry;

ARTICLE 12: COMMITTEE APPOINTMENTS AND PROCEDURES

12.2 Eligibility for Appointed Committee Members

(a) A Member of the College is eligible for appointment as an Appointed Committee Member if, on the date of the appointment:

(viii) the Member has resigned, before being appointed, any position such as director, owner, board member, officer or employee that the member holds with a professional association relating to opticianry;

(a) A Member Registrant of the College is eligible for appointment as an Appointed Committee Member if, on the date of the appointment:

(viii) the Member Registrant has resigned, before at least three years prior to being appointed, any position such as director, owner, board member, officer or employee that the member holds with a
