
ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND UNDERTAKING

I, Anthony Bodington, hereby acknowledge and undertake as follows:


1. I acknowledge that allegations of professional misconduct against me, as yet unproven, were referred to the Discipline Committee of the College of Opticians of Ontario (the "College"). The allegations include concerns that I failed to comply with the requirements of the College's Quality Assurance program and that I failed to comply with an order of the Inquiries, Complaints and Reports Committee of the College.
2. I acknowledge that if the allegations were proven at a discipline hearing, the Discipline Committee could order one or more penalties pursuant to its authority under the *Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991*, up to and including the suspension or revocation of my certificate of registration.
3. In exchange for the College adjourning the discipline hearing *sine die* and not proceeding with a formal discipline hearing, I hereby undertake to resign and surrender my membership in, and certificate of registration with, the College immediately upon the signing of this Acknowledgement and Undertaking.
4. I acknowledge that if I ever reapply for membership, registration, licensure or similar status with the College in the future I will not be entitled to reinstatement and that instead I will be required to submit a new application for registration with the College and meet all registration requirements that are in place at the time of my application.
5. I further acknowledge that if I ever reapply for membership, registration, licensure or similar status with the College in the future the College will be entitled to proceed with the discipline hearing with respect to the allegations referred to above, and will be entitled to rely upon this Acknowledgment and Undertaking for that purpose.
6. I acknowledge that as a result of my resignation, I am prohibited, in the Province of Ontario, from:

- a. Dispensing eyeglasses, contact lenses or subnormal vision devices;
 - b. Using the title "optician" or any abbreviation thereof or equivalent in another language
 - c. Holding myself out as a person who is qualified to practice as an optician;
 - d. Supervising any registered student optician or intern optician or delegate any controlled acts to non-opticians;
 - e. Wearing my photographic identification badge; and
 - f. Publicly displaying my certificate of registration.
7. I acknowledge that the College is required to include the fact of my resignation and the terms of this undertaking on the College register pursuant to subsection 23(2) paragraphs 11 and 17 of the Health Professions Procedural Code, which is Schedule 2 to the *Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991*.
8. I understand, acknowledge and agree that:
- a. I fully understand the terms of this Acknowledgment and Undertaking;
 - b. I am signing this Acknowledgement and Undertaking voluntarily and without compulsion or duress;
 - c. I have been strongly advised by the College to obtain independent legal advice prior to signing this Acknowledgment and Undertaking and that I have either done so or I have had an adequate opportunity to do so; and
 - d. A breach of any of the terms of this undertaking may constitute professional misconduct on my part for which the College may take action against me and this Acknowledgment and Undertaking is admissible in any such proceeding.
