

34 (the "*Opticianry Act*") and, in particular, refrain from doing the following unless and until he is so authorized:

- a. Using the title "optician" or a variation or abbreviation or an equivalent in another language;
- b. Holding himself out as a person who is qualified to practise in Ontario as an optician or in a specialty of opticianry; and
- c. Performing any acts that constitute the practice of opticianry in Ontario pursuant to sections 3 and 4 of the *Opticianry Act*.

2. THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the Respondent pay to the Applicant the costs of this application fixed in the amount of \$12,000.00 to be paid in 33 monthly installments as follows:

- a. Installments 1-32 shall be in the amount of \$363.00;
- b. Installment 33 shall be in the amount of \$384.00;
- c. The first monthly installment shall be due within 30 days of the date of this Order and then every month thereafter until payment is complete; and
- d. Failure to pay any monthly installment in accordance with the terms above will result in the total remaining amount of costs becoming immediately due and payable.

THIS ORDER BEARS INTEREST at the rate of four percent per year commencing on the date of this Order.
