FAQ'S NACOR PILOT PROJECT

How do I participate?

To participate decide which form you want to complete and follow the link provided in the email. You will be asked a series of demographic questions to start.

How do I receive CE hours?

At the end of the pilot Wickett Measurement Systems reviews data and eliminates anyone who randomly guessed or did not spend a legitimate amount of time completing the pilot.

If you wish to receive CE hours you will be asked to supply your name, license number, province, and email at the end of the form before you submit it. After December 31, you will receive an email confirming that you have completed the pilot and the number of hours you received; this can be uploaded as your completion certificate. To ensure you receive this email enter jhay@nacor.ca into your safe senders list.

** Please note, you should report the activities completed in the Accredited Hour section of your portal once you complete have completed the pilot and, upload the confirmation from NACOR as soon as you receive it. Accreditation numbers for each pilot can be found in the table below.

What year will my credits be awarded for?

Your CE hours will be awarded for 2022.

What are the credit values?

How long do I have to complete a form?

Forms must be completed in one sitting; you cannot save your answers and return to it at a later date.

Can I complete the pilot anonymously?

You can complete the forms anonymously if you wish, but you would not receive CE credits or be entered in the draw as your contact information is needed for both of these.

Can I complete more than one form?

You can complete Eyeglasses and Contact Lenses individually **OR** the combined Eyeglasses and Contact Lenses. The maximum number of credits you can receive for participating in the pilot is 4, you will not receive additional CE hours for completing all 3 pilot tests.

Who will receive my results when I complete a form?

The forms will not be marked and therefore no one will receive your results. The purpose of this pilot is strictly to see how these questions perform and therefore we do not need the forms to be marked on an individual basis.

Who will receive my answers?

Wickett Measurement Systems, a test development company will receive your answers, they will share the data they compile for this pilot with the National Examination Committee in an aggregate form only.
